**Site Visit to KCRC Lok Ma Chau Spur Line
on Saturday, 21 January 2006**

The Lok Ma Chau Spur Line will be the second railway link between Hong Kong and the Mainland, relieving passenger congestion at Lo Wu Station. The 7.4 kilometre alignment will run from East Rail's Sheung Shui Station to Lok Ma Chau Station.

The KCRC adopted a combined tunnel and viaduct scheme for the Spur Line: from Sheung Shui to Chau Tau, the railway will run through tunnels and will then run on viaducts until it reaches Lok Ma Chau Station. Construction commenced in January 2003 and the project is targeted for completion in 2007.

To help our members appreciate the benefits of the Lok Ma Chau Spur Line and become familiar with the new service, our Association will organise a site visit with programme as attached. Details of the visit are as follows.
