AES organized the “Forum on Lantau Tomorrow – Sustainable Development” on 20 February 2019 evening with co-organizers including Department of Civil and Environmental Engineering of Hong Kong Polytechnic University, ASCE Hong Kong Section, ICE Hong Kong, Hong Kong Institution of Planning Engineers, ASHARE Hong Kong Chapter and The Institution of Engineering and Technology, and supporting organizations of Civil Engineering and Development Department of the HKSAR Government and CIWEM Hong Kong Branch. The guest speaker was Ir Janson Wong Chi-sing, JP, the Deputy Head of the Sustainable Lantau Office (Works). The response was overwhelming with over 230 mainly young engineering professionals participating.

In the first part of the Forum, Ir Janson Wong presented the visions of the project to provide land for housing and economic developments of Hong Kong including reclamation in the Central Water of Hong Kong and along the northern shore of Lantau Island and western part of New Territories. The project improves the facilities in the southern part of Lantau Island for recreation activities. After the presentation, Ir Janson Wong together with his Chief Engineers, Ir Andy Lok and Ir Joyce Lau responded to questions from the participants in the second part of the Forum. All questions raised showed support to proceed with the reclamation project and some even suggested to commence earlier and implement faster to release the huge pressure on shortage of land supply.

Lantau Tomorrow Vision is a development project which was announced in the 2018 Policy Address and it has come with many debates in the society.

In the evening of 20 February 2019, AES organized the “Lantau Tomorrow – Sustainable Development Forum” at the Hong Kong Polytechnic University. The event was also co-organized with the Department of Civil and Environmental Engineering of the PolyU, ASCE, ICE, HKIPE, ASHARE and IET. There were about 240 participants in total, majority of whom were young engineers and university students.

In the first part of the event, Ir Janson Wong Chi-sing, Deputy Head of the Sustainable Lantau Office (Works) of the Civil Engineering and Development Department of the HKSAR Government, began the talk with an informative presentation on the Lantau Tomorrow Vision. It gave better understanding of the overall development, conservation proposal, and the strategic location and transport infrastructures suggested. It was followed with the question-and-answer session. During this part, the participants spoke enthusiastically and shared their thoughts on the Vision from an engineering point of view.

All the participants were very satisfied with this informative Forum as it was a valuable opportunity for all to foresee now the engineering industry will be benefited by the Vision.
