

Trunk Road T2 and Cha Kwo Ling Tunnel ("The Project") forms the middle section of Route 6, connecting the Central Kowloon Route (CKR) to the west and the main tunnel of the Tseung Kwan O - Lam Tin Tunnel (TKO-LTT) to the east. Upon commissioning of the entire Route 6, journey time during peak hours between Tseung Kwan O Town Centre and Yau Ma Tei will be substantially reduced from about 65 minutes now to 12 minutes. The Project comprises 3.4 km of dual two-lane trunk road, 3.1 km of which is in the form of tunnels. The tunnels will be constructed mainly by using two 14 m diameter Tunnel Boring Machines (TBMs) drilling concurrently. The merits of TBM tunnelling in this Project are to avoid disturbance to the seabed, minimize disruptions to the operation of Kwun Tong Typhoon Shelter, Kwun Tong Pier and existing coastal facilities, and allow the public to enjoy the harbourfront as usual. In this event, participants will be given a briefing on the TBM tunnelling works, the construction challenges encountered and the smart and innovative technologies applied in the Project, followed by a virtual site visit. The visit will be concluded by a Q&A session hosted by the site representatives. All the presentation and visit will be conducted on the live streaming platform. The virtual visit will be conducted in Cantonese, supplemented with English captions and PowerPoint slides.
