Delegation Visit to Singapore 27 -30 May 2009 (Wed - Sat)

The Association of Engineering Professionals in Society (AES) is organizing a technical visit to Singapore between 27-30 May 2009. The aims of this 4-day delegation visit are to enable Hong Kong engineers to understand more about historical conservation, railway development, waste treatment and energy conservation in Singapore, and to explore the co-operation opportunities among the entrepreneurs in Hong Kong and Singapore.
